**Ball Control** - Maintains possession under pressure and shields the ball. Uses all surfaces to dribble. Uses fakes, feints and speed changes. Uses various body parts to trap and control the ball.

**Passing** - Recognizes passing lanes. Passes to space, leading the receiving player. Passes are well timed, accurate and of correct pace. Understands and utilizes back passes.

**Power** - Can clear the penalty area, in the air, on Goal Kicks. Can place the ball in front of the goal on Corner Kicks. Can shoot from outside the Penalty Area.

**Speed** - Is fast and agile. Can beat others to the ball. Moves quickly and under control with and without the ball. Maintains balance while making fast starts, cuts and stops.

**Scoring** - Puts the ball IN THE NET from various distances. Follows shots to the goal. Takes advantage of rebound opportunities. Shoots to open area away from the Goal Keeper.

**Defending** - Understands when to delay and when to tackle. Does both successfully, without overcommitting. Establishes appropriate marking distance. Maintains goal-side, ball-side position.

**Keeper** - Is aggressive to the ball and does what it takes to regain possession. Knows when to come out of the goal. Has a good punt and throw. Communicates with the defense.

**Awareness** - Sees what is happening on the entire field. Communicates with teammates. Plays both on and off the ball and provides support. Anticipates the action and creates options.

**Attitude** - Works hard and is willing to learn. Displays good sportsmanship to everyone. Understands that it is about the TEAM not the individual. Is supportive of teammates and is a Leader.

**Parents** - Parents provide positive support at games and do not coach from the sidelines. Parents volunteer to assist in team functions. Parents respect time frames set by the coach.
