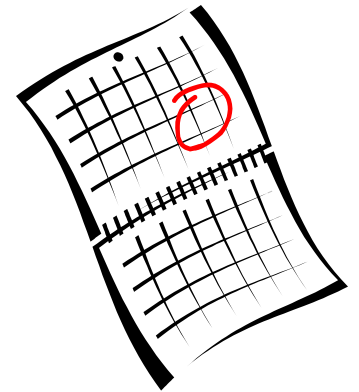

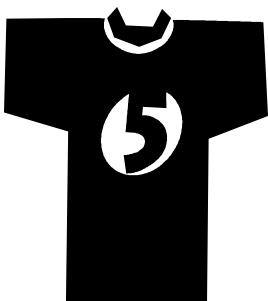
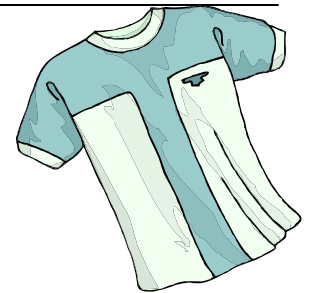


Hey Coaches!

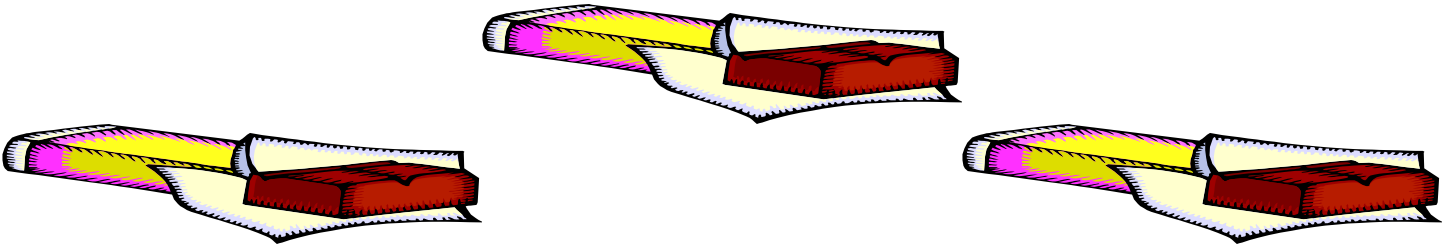
Pinnies that are borrowed for games with uniform colors that are the same, need to be checked out from Jill Owen and returned to her after your game.

Candy Fundraiser News

You need to know!



Parents & Teams,

Our fundraiser has been going quite well. I would like to thank everyone for taking part. As we are gearing down and selling the last of our boxes, here are a few reminders:

There are two options for the fundraiser candy sales (1) All team members have the option of opting out and not selling the candy bars but agree to pay \$25.00. (2) Selling a box of World's Finest candy bars, valued at \$50.00.

If you selected to sell the candy bars, you have agreed to sell the box of candy. There should be no candy bars returned and a check for \$50.00 should be given to the Fundraiser parent of your child's team. We are aware that there are some families that have multiple children playing for AYSO Region 206. Although, that can be a lot of candy to sell, it costs \$100.00+ for each child to play soccer. In order to keep our costs down, we do this fundraiser. I thank you for your understanding and participation.

Candy Sales end, Oct 12th. All money should be turned into your Team Fundraiser Parent on or before Oct 12th. Many teams are requesting all the money be turned in as early as Oct 10th. to allow the Team Fundraiser parent a chance to gather everything together and get paperwork completed before the deadline. We are asking, instead of sending cash that one check per player be turned in for the total amount that player owes for candy sales. This will be easier on the fundraiser parent as well as those of us checking in the money and doing the paperwork on Oct 12th.

Fundraiser Parents, please have your yellow envelopes filled out and money counted and ready to be turned in on Oct 12th, 6 PM to 8 PM. Please also have a count of the number of Soccer Light Up Necklaces (U5, U6, U8) that you will need for your team. Necklaces are awarded for EACH box sold. If a player sold 5 boxes, they will get 5 Soccer light up necklaces. For the older teams (U10, U12, U14), please know the number of Snack Dispensers you will need. Only one Snack Dispenser per player. In order to be eligible for the incentives, the team member's must have sold and turned in money for an entire box of candy. Those that elected to opt out and have paid their \$25.00, are awarded the incentive. Please include them with your counts. Also, please be sure to put the parent signature forms inside the envelope and turn those in with your money. This will make things much more organized and we can get you in and out faster that evening. Please be sure to have a list of your top sellers. We will need the team number, the number of boxes they have sold (and have turned in their money) their name and home telephone number. We will notify the player's families and prize selection will be done after all teams have turned in their money and our paperwork is finalized.

If there are any unopened boxes you may have from player's opting out, please contact me. I would like to collect these boxes ASAP. We do have players going for the Top 5 Sellers prizes and we could use any un-
